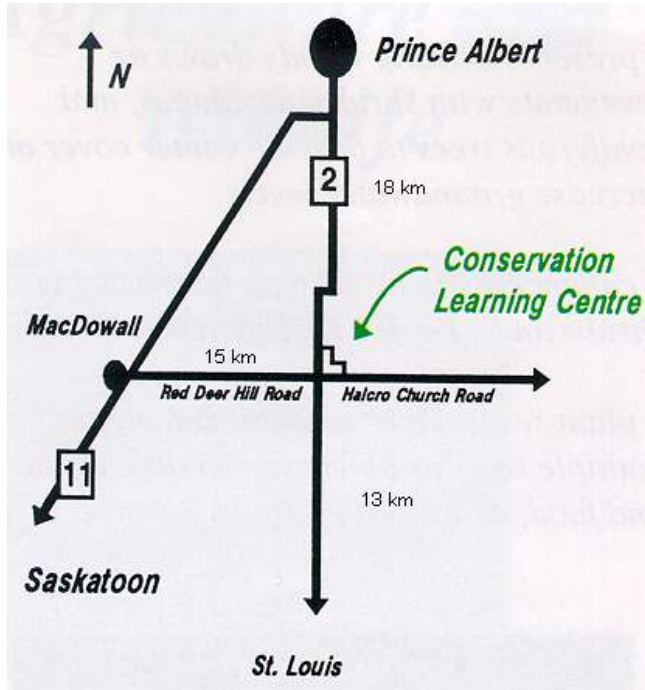
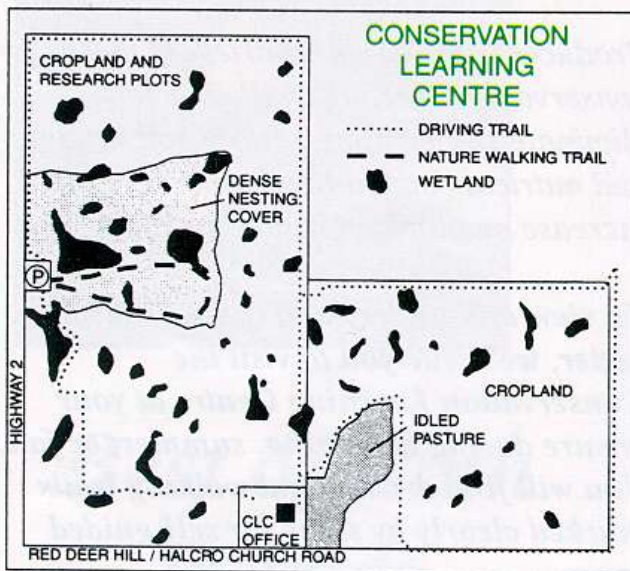


Map to the CLC

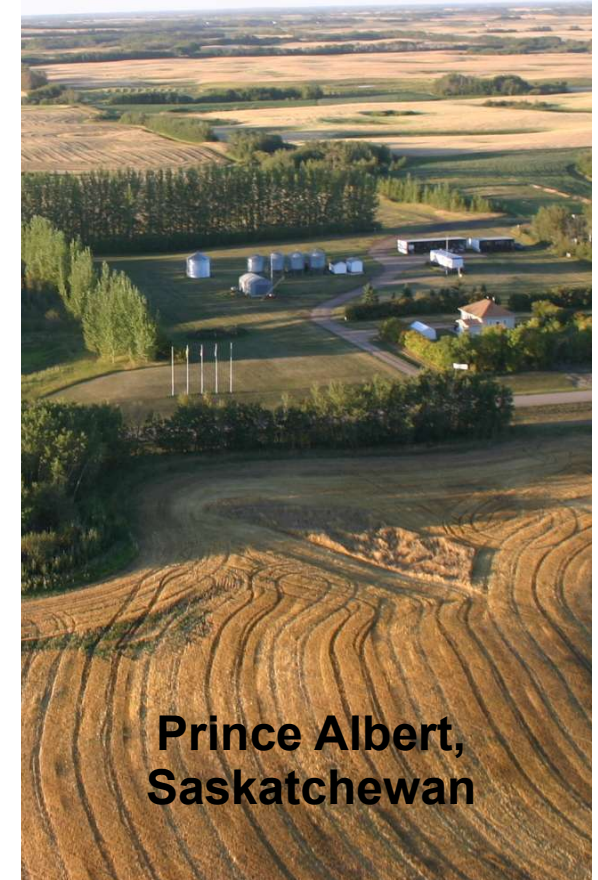

The Conservation Learning Centre is located near Prince Albert Saskatchewan on 457 acres of land. This land is used for annual cultivation (250 acres), forage production, dense nesting cover, shelterbelts, riparian areas, a herb garden and a nature trail.
