- Operating small plot field equipment such as tractors, seeders, sprayers, and tillage tools
- Driving a truck and trailer to move equipment between sites
- Taking accurate and precise field notes during data collection
- Operating a small plot combine or swather
- Fall Land preparation
- Equipment calibration and maintenance
- Assisting technicians and agronomists
- Yard maintenance
- Gardening (planting, weeding, harvest)
- Leading school group tours
- Helping host field days
