

## CLC Shamrock Grain Bag Roller instructions:

\*Always ensure the grain bag is not frozen to the ground and shaken out as much as possible. If your bag is full of snow and ice (or water) drive your tractor onto the bag so you are facing down the length of the bag. Go through steps 1-4. Drive until you have flipped your bag completely over. Another method to remove water is to slit the bag as it is being rolled in.

1. Put the grain bag over the first bar and under the second bar.
2. Bring your spear out approx. 1'.
3. Hold the bag over the hole and stab the bag with the spear. Other users have found folding the bag four times and jamming into the slit of the spear also works.
4. Start rotating spear clockwise.
5. Wrap up your bag.
6. Tie the bag using baler twine.
7. To remove the spear, you need to reverse the spear (counter clockwise) and use the cylinder to push the spear out at the same time. This means you should be pulling both levers towards you when releasing the bag.
8. Use the kicker to kick out the bag.

Other users have found that larger bags/rolls may be more difficult to roll and eject. Cutting long bags into shorter lengths may make the rolling and transport of the bags more manageable.
